Provision for children of key workers

As you know all schools in Scotland will be closing to the majority of pupils as of this afternoon. From Monday there will be some staff in All Saints to support the children of key workers (please see UK Government definition of keyworkers <https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/coronavirus-covid-19-maintaining-educational-provision/guidance-for-schools-colleges-and-local-authorities-on-maintaining-educational-provision>). A bus from Milton will still be running in order to collect the children of key workers and bring them to school and then take them home. The school will be open for these children from 8.30am-3pm.
