I hope my letter finds you and yours well.

We finish this Friday at 2:30pm for the Christmas holidays, after a busy and successful term. School returns for everyone from **8:50am on Monday**, **6**th **of January 2025**.

S4-S6 Prelim Results

All marking, quality assurance and checks of prelim papers will conclude during the first week of the new term. As such, young people in S4, S5 and S6 will receive their prelim exams results certificate week beginning 13th of January 2025.

I will meet with Year Heads and Subject Leaders in early January to review the prelim results and to begin the processes around confirmation of SQA presentation levels – this is normally confirmed by late February and communicated to the SQA in March.

Our young people will begin to receive focused feedback to support their learning from the first week of the new term (whole-class feedback) and from prelim results day onwards (individual/targeted feedback as applicable).

Please contact your child's Pupil Support Teacher if you wish to discuss your child's progress. We are happy to help.

S1-S2 Tracking Reports

The second tracking report for S1 and S2 pupils is due out just after the Christmas break; this will include, for the first time, specific information about *how* the tracking decision was made by your child's teachers. I will be interested to hear your views on how useful this information is so please look out for a survey in follow-up to help you let me know what you think.

At our last Parent Council meeting, I was delighted that we were able to recruit some new members. You will recall I have said before that many of our long-standing members have now moved on as their children have left school. It was lovely to see new parents/carers joining.
