Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you and yours are well. **Tomorrow at 1pm** marks the end of another busy and successful school year in All Saints' RC Secondary. I am writing to update you on some areas of school business to both round off this session and to help with preparations for the new session, which starts (for pupils) on **Wednesday**, **16**th **August 2023 at 8:50am**.

Vision, Values and Public Promise

As I mentioned in my letter in May, we have been working on and have now completed the ideas-gathering and discussion part of our consultation around our new Vision, Values & Public Promise. I can't thank you enough for your engagement in this process. We will be launching these early in the new term and I will write to you again to update you in due course.

Return to School, SQA Results, Options Choices

The SQA will publish exam results on **Tuesday, 8th of August**. The vast majority of young people will receive these by text message or via their MySQA App around 8am on that day, with the Royal Mail delivering traditional envelopes later that day.

There will be opportunities around this time for young people to come into school to discuss their results, seek advice, and discuss any changes to their options for next session, should this be required.

As usual, we will write to you again in early August with the specific arrangements for this and to give the details for the first days back for **all pupils** on the 16th August.

Acting Depute Headteachers x 2

This change required that we recruit a new Acting Depute Headteacher to cover for Ms Hewitt's secondment (the post Mrs Bell was filling). Additionally, Mrs Bell is due to commence Maternity Leave early in the new session; as such, I have now recruited 2 x new Acting Depute Headteachers, as follows:
