Our New S1

We are all very much looking forward to welcoming our new S1 cohort to All Saints' from August. Moving from P7 into secondary school is a significant – and very exciting – time for young people; a key transition. We are all set and ready to see our new S1s after the summer holidays. A warm welcome to the All Saints' community to you all. You'll see below details of some key people you can contact if you need anything or if you have any queries.

Uniform

As you know, we are a uniform wearing school, and we have a strict policy around this to ensure equity, fairness and safety of all – this is a key part of our ethos.

Can I ask that, if purchasing new things for your child during the summer, <u>you do not purchase</u> <u>any coloured trainers: Converse, Campus or any equivalents.</u> These are not allowed in <u>our school</u>. Please purchase only plain black school shoes or trainers.

As always, if you need any support with uniform, please get in touch – we are happy to help.

Return to School, SQA Results, Options Choices

The SQA will publish exam results on **Tuesday**, **5**th **of August**. The vast majority of young people will receive these by text message or via their MySQA App around 8am, with the Royal Mail delivering traditional envelopes later that day.

There will be opportunities around this time for young people to come into school to discuss their results, seek advice, and discuss any changes to their options for next session, should this be required. Pupils can also email their Year Head or Pupil Support Teacher. Colleagues from Skills Development Scotland will also be available around this time to support with destinations should advice be required.

Pupils should check in with their Year Teams page for details on what to do (and when). Updates will be communicated in early August.

Prior to the new term starting, in early August, I will also write out to all parents with 'day 1' details.
