


Life in Abraham's Time-


3. Abraham - Imagine you are Abraham. Write a postcard to a friend back home about why you left your homeland and how you fell about it now. Use the following words:

Belief and Ritual - Think of 3 thing's a person might WEAR that shows some thing they believe, eg a badge, jewellery, headwear Report back to the class your findings.





Worship in the synagogue - Find out about a synagogue here in Glasgow. List 3 ways that worship would be different in a synagogue than it would be in a church.






imprisoned in the camp.

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
22. **Judaism Worldwide-** Investigate a period of persecution in the Jewish history.
